Continue **steadfastly** in prayer,
being **watchful**, with **thanksgiving**.

At the same time, pray also that
God may **open a door** for the **word**,
to **declare** the mystery of Christ, to
make it clear.

Walk in wisdom towards outsiders,
making the **best use of the time**.

Let your **speech** always be **gracious**,
seasoned with **salt**,
that you may know how to **answer**
each person.

(from Colossians 4:2-6 ESV)

Remember Jesus' promise:

“Ask and it shall be given. Seek and you will find.

Knock and the door will be opened! ” Luke 7:7

As you walk, ask the Holy Spirit for help. **Continue steadfastly. Walk in wisdom**

Keep your eyes open for people and situations to pray about. **Being watchful**

Thank God for all the good things happening in your school and for the people in it.

With thanksgiving

Ask Him to open doors for Christian students, teachers and other staff and anyone visiting to lead assemblies, lessons or other meetings and events. **To make the most of every opportunity.**

Pray for wisdom to know when to share about Jesus – to say the right thing in the right way.

Declare the Gospel - let your speech be gracious, seasoned with salt,

ready to respond to anyone who asks.

Old Testament leader Joshua led the people to possess the Promised Land. He needed courage and had to trust in God's promise to him.

*“I will give you every place where you set your foot... Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be **discouraged**, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.” Joshua 1:3,9*

God wants to bring blessing in our schools and answer our prayers to drive out evil influence and unkindness, give people the encouragement and comfort they need, cause them to think about the important questions and begin to walk with Jesus.

Dear Lord, as we walk, pray and get involved in our schools may we keep our eyes fixed on you. Amen.
