
Lord, teach us to pray!

"Lord, teach us to pray!" Fourteen daily prayers for Pray for Schools Fortnight

SUN 12	Pray for renewed encouragement for Christian parents, teachers and other staff, schools' workers, students and others, as they engage with their local schools.
MON 13	Ask God to help those preparing for exams; to concentrate on revision, retain information, and stay healthy - to do their best and gain the results they deserve.
TUE 14	Pray for Head Teachers and others in senior leadership roles; that God would grant them wisdom with important decisions and undertaking challenging tasks.
WED 15	Intercede that the children will learn more of the truth and grace of the gospel – from assemblies, RE lessons, local church ministers and Christian staff and visitors.
THUR 16	Give thanks for the contribution of Christian schools to the education of so many children. Pray that they will continue to be free to teach biblical truth and values.
FRI 17	Ask God to raise up many Christians to serve as School Governors, on fundraising and other committees, volunteering in classrooms and in other practical ways.
SAT 18	Remember the invaluable contribution of non-teaching school staff: providing administrative back-up, caring for buildings and grounds, supervising children at lunchtimes and giving other support.
SUN 19	Ask God to grant Education Secretary Damian Hinds MP and his team insight and wisdom as they deal with teachers, parents, local authorities and other agencies.
MON 20	Intercede for the growing numbers of children affected by bullying. Pray for those helping them to cope with mental health issues and other problems caused by this.
TUE 21	Remember teachers and other staff working with children who have special needs. Pray that they will receive grace and patience from God and find joy in all they do.
WED 22	Ask God to grant wisdom to those responsible for education budgets nationally and in local authorities. Pray for fairness and skill to spend available funds wisely.
THUR 23	Pray that Governors and parents will not be required to accept Relationship and Sex Education curriculum content that they believe is unsuitable for their children.
FRI 24	Thank God for thousands of groups and individuals who pray regularly for schools. Pray for encouragement to keep believing for the answers to their prayers.
SAT 25	Intercede for the safety of children and young people in schools, especially those in communities that are affected by gang culture and other social challenges.
