## Ephesians 4 v 32

"Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ, God forgave you."

Love consists of so many things! The Bible tells us that 'God is love' and that He wants us to be like Him and love others, even when that's a big ask.

It's not so difficult to love our friends, get on with others in our school and respect teachers we like and admire. But living out this Bible verse is far harder for us when someone is a bully, dishonest or unfair. We can ask the Holy Spirit to help us to be understanding and not just hit back or hate that person.

Y Kindness looks for opportunities to make life easier for others

**Compassion** puts itself in the other person's place and tries to understands their hurt, why they act as they do.

**Forgiveness** decides not to hold it against someone who's upset us but remember we're none of us perfect. Jesus set us free from so much when He forgave us and we can do the same.

Lord Jesus, I'm not always a good person – nobody is! But please help me in school to love other people with Your love. If I am kind, compassionate and forgiving they might see something of You and bad situations could get better. Amen.

# Ideas to "Bless our schools"

# > Pray

Meet with other like-minded people and regularly pray for your school. This can be weekly, monthly, half termly. Maybe link with other Christians who pray and ask for the focus once a term to be on schools and young people. Some groups pray in the morning. Others organise a meeting at lunch time and pray after sandwiches. Many pray in the evening with Christians from all churches in their area after a time of worship.

- Ask teachers or staff if they have any prayer requests. Some groups with permission put a prayer box in reception or the staff room.
- Pray and encourage all those you know who work in schools. Find out which classes the children in your church are in and encourage them to pray for them too
- Pray for our teachers, teaching assistants and the whole school community, for the children and young people perhaps focus on a different class each day

There may be jobs in the classroom or in school that need doing -

- Cleaning out paint pots, photocopying or sharpening pencils
- 💙 Offer to help pick up litter
- 💙 Listen to children read

- Help the school start something "Green" e.g. Recycling, using less plastic or even creating a outside nature area.

Ideas for Children to "Bless our schools"

- **Pray**: for your teachers, teaching assistants, lunch time supervisors and support staff. Ask your Sunday school leaders to pray for your school.

    - Make a thank you card for your teacher, teaching assistant, caretaker or lunchtime supervisor. Write a letter, draw a picture or perhaps use buttons and make some button people.
    - **Offer to help:** Ask how you can help in your classroom or at break
      - Be good and helpful in class.
      - Be kind to everyone
  - Y Obey school rules and be punctual for lessons
  - **Sit next to someone** you don't normally sit with at lunchtime
- Ask your grown-up about their day on your way home or at teatime
