Those who give mercy to others are happy.

Mercy will be given to them.

Those who are pure in their thinking are happy.

They will be with God.

Those who work to bring peace are happy.

God will call them his sons and daughters.

(Matthew 5:6-9 International Children's Bible)

Grant hope and success as these young people find the will and energy to try their best and rescue them when they fail. Amen.

Fulfilment now and in the future

Merciful God, we ask for these young people to have opportunities and inspiration to discover what You have placed within them – creativity, leadership, caring hearts, special skills and passions – and grow and flourish. We pray for your light and love to shine upon children who are unable to thrive in this way. Amen.

Security and guidance

Jesus our Saviour, please help all who work with young people who are in trouble through their unwise choices: using drugs and alcohol, caught up in harmful online activity, involved in gangs and other difficult situations. We pray for freedom to turn away and seek what is good for their lives, now and in the future. Amen.
